RN-BSN Completion Scholarship (The remaining annual interest/earnings after the annual KNF maintenance fee and return of 5% of the interest earnings to the principal)	<p>Additional Criteria</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Only applicants who are Kansas residents are eligible</li> <li>2. The Scholarship shall be given to applicants enrolled in a Kansas RN-BSN completion program</li> <li>3.
